It is recommended that you meet with a Liberals Arts Academic Counselor at least once a semester to ensure that you are fulfilling the Associate of Arts Degree requirements. 2. W courses must have a grade of "C" or higher. Only one English course with the exception of English 209 may be used to fulfill the W requirement. 3. ** Zool 200 will be accepted as meeting Group 1 Biological Science with Lab (DB,DY). Exception of 6 total credits for Natural Sciences will be made. 4. Residency Requirement: The final twelve (12) credits applicable to the degree or thirty (30) credits applicable to the degree must be earned from HCC. This requirement may be waived. See academic counselor for more information. 5. When there is a break in enrollment for more than one year, you must use the graduation requirements in effect at the time of graduation. 6. Submit graduation application by March 15 for Spring and October 15 for Fall. No graduation in the Summer.
